Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

The swedge for the drain valve on the condensate tank leaked around the threads where it screws into the tank. Suspected that it was caused by a freeze. Approximately 42 bbls of condensate and 10 bbls of produced water leaked into the bermed area and soaked into the ground.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

All fluids soaked into the ground next to the storage tank. Plans are to move the tank and excavate the impacted soils.
