Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* The hydraulic line on the rig broke. The flow of liquids was stopped and the line was replaced.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* An 8x10 foot area was impacted by the release. Absorbent pads were used to soak up approximately half of the fluids. As the impacted area is under the rig ramp, clean up can not begin until the rig moves off of location (on 11/19/2004). The area will be excavated and the soil landfilled.
