
Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.*

Tech arrived at location to check on compressor that had gone down, and discovered that someone had purposely shut the compressor down, removed a plug from the day tank, and opened a fill valve on the day tank allowing the oil to drain to the ground. Automation shows this to have happened at 8:10PM the evening of the 17th. Release was due to vandalism. San Juan County Sheriffs office notified.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.*

Truck was called out to remove standing oil and contaminated soil. Soil and oil hauled to JFJ landfarm for remediation.
