During the course of flowing back the well to the blow pit, the well started to produce some liquids. An attempt to light the flowback stream failed. Wind carried a mist of hydrocarbon liquid over the blow pit berm and over an approximate area of 100 yds by 250 yds.

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.\*

The hydrocarbon mist impacted an area approximately 300 yds by 250 yds. The impacted soils will be removed and landfarmed onsite.
