Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken.* **On May 17, 2010, it was discovered that the water pit tank was leaking due to corrosion. Upon discovery, the well was shut-in and a water truck was called to location.**

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken.* **All fluid remained within the pit & cribbing. Approximately 24.5 BBL of fluid were recovered. The pit tank does have a liner underneath it but ConocoPhillips will assess the soils after the pit and liner is pulled.**
