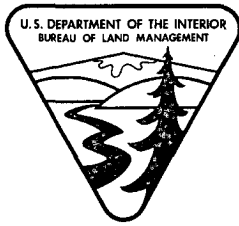

RE:Release Of Operator Bond Period of Liability-Pinion Mesa B-1 gas well in S25, T31N, R14W

Dear Operator:

The Bureau of Land Management (BLM) approved a Notice of Intent to Abandon the Pinion Mesa B-1 well (API# 30-045-21608) on November 2, 2004. The well is located on Lease #MOOC-1420-0625. Plugging procedures were completed on November 22, 2004. Surface reclamation was accomplished and a Subsequent Report for Abandonment received on December 13, 2004 by the Bureau of Land Management and found to meet requirements regarding the down-hole plugging of the well. The Final Abandonment Notice (FAN) indicating operator verification that the surface has been contoured to blend with surrounding terrain, had equipment removed and reclaimed with growth of desirable vegetation at 70% of surrounding undisturbed lands was received by the BLM-SJRA and approved on April 13, 2011. A field inspection was made by BLM, Conocophillips (Burlington O&F Resources Inc.) and BIA-UMU Agency personnel on April 13, 2011. Surface reclamation approval was determined to be pending the removal of one anchor and the removal of a section of electrical wiring. E-mail correspondence

from Norm Favor of Conocophillips on 4/15/2011 indicated that these items had been removed and the disturbed area leveled and seeded. Final surface reclamation was approved by the Bureau of Indian Affairs-UMU Agency on April 19, 2011 and e-mailed to the BLM on April 20, 2011 with original received April 25, 2011. The Final Abandonment Notice received March 16, 2011 was approved by the Bureau of Land Management on April 28, 2011.

It has been determined that the period of liability with regards to this well is terminated and the bond for this well may be released. If the bond covering this well is an individual well bond, you may seek release of funds from the Minerals Adjudication Officer, BIA-UMU Agency (970-565-8473) at the following address:
