Please consider this letter as formal request from Andro-Eidal Co to drill the above well on an unorthodox location 1601 feet from the East line and 804 feet from the ~~South~~ *North* line of Sec 4, T15N, R4W, N10E, McKinley County, N Mex.

Blanket Bond has been previously filed, and approved.

This will be our fourth attempt to secure commercial production in this area. Three other attempts were made in the twenties and one in 1947, by others. The area is complicated by faulting. Information on the old wells is somewhat sketchy and undependable. However, we now feel that with the total information, from subsurface and geophysical work, that the above location will put us structurally higher in the objective sand, and it was picked solely for this purpose.

We are also asking for a somewhat unorthodox method of completion, although it is being used more and more extensively in many areas. The method has been verbally discussed between J Mayhew and Emery Arnold, and verbally approved. Of course, should the hole be dry it would be properly plugged.

Your early consideration and approval will be appreciated.

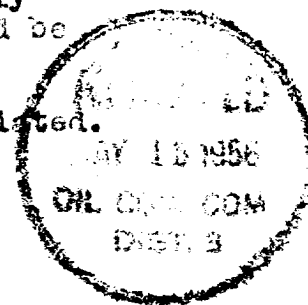
