**4-11-60** Perforations 1150-52; 1150-12. These points were freed with 1500# 20-40 sand and 16,000 gallons of oil. It 30 BHP w/20 sand per gallon. BHP 2 1600# treating pressure 12-1300#. Rigged up and ran Baker Model M. Prod. packer set at 1200. BHP 200# in 30 minutes. Attempted 30 balls with no success getting them in. Went in waiting to perforate, treat and test shale same before working further on above points.
