Our records indicate the above well was completed in July, 1962 at a total depth of 343 feet. Miscellaneous reports were filed on the well indicating that production was not secured and that the well would probably be plugged and abandoned. Our records do not indicate that the well has been plugged and we are therefore directing that it immediately be plugged according to New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission rules and regulations.. Well Record, Form C-105 and Form C-102 should both be filed prior to plugging. Form C-103 should be filed subsequent to plugging setting out the details of the plugging program.
