Please refer to my letter of February 22, 1967 concerning the above well.

Subsequent to my letter, Tidewater Oil Company and Mr. Buck Willcoxson, the land owner, reached agreement on conversion of the well to a water well. The well has now been cased with $4\frac{1}{2}$ inch casing to 1871 feet and cemented with 40 sacks of cement, and this work has been properly reported on Oil Conservation Commission form C-103. We also have received properly executed Affidavit of Conversion to Water Well forms signed by both parties. I am enclosing copies for your files.
