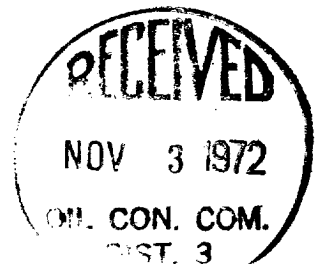
By authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 10 of Order No. R-4263, the above-described unorthodox location is hereby approved.
