Herewith are three deviation records that were made of the last 1000 feet of hole drilled on the subject well. The one at 3000 feet is missing out of its envelope, but assure the commission that the ½ degree reading was the true recording.

Deviations were taken at 1000 feet and 1500 feet by drillers who had no previous experience with Totco instruments but were shown how to run them. Upon examination, there were no marks on the degree sheet, thus they did not record or the timer did not work right.
