On 11-2-79 deviation tests were conducted by employees of WTR Oil Company Well # 1 located 350' FSL 350' FWL Sec 10 T19N R6W McKinley County New Mexico

Technical Oil Tool Corporation equipment was used as follows:

1. First survey at approximate depth of 500' below the surface indicated a drift of $\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ vertical.
2. Second survey at approximate depth of 1000' below the surface indicated a drift of 0° from vertical.
3. Third survey at approximate depth of 1500' below the surface indicated a drift of 1° from vertical.
4. Fourth survey at approximate depth of 2000' below the surface indicated a drift of 1° from vertical.
5. Fifth survey at approximate depth of 2250' below the surface indicated a drift of $\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ from vertical.

The records of the above surveys are on file in the office of WTR Oil Company P.O. Drawer H Cortez, Colorado.

Reference is made to the Bureau of Land Management's letter, dated December 6, 1988, requiring that subject well be plugged within 30 days, and Texaco's January 5, 1989 letter to Woosley Oil Company, Operator of the WTR No. 1 well, a copy of which was sent to the Bureau of Land Management. During a phone conversation on January 18, 1989, with Mr. Stephen Mason, Mr. Merlin Ekman advised that Mr. James Woosley had called that morning in response to our letter and informed us that he had filed for bankruptcy. However, he assured us that he could arrange for the plugging of the well within 90 days if an extension to the plugging order could be obtained.

Texaco respectfully requests that a ninety-day extension (until April 18, 1989) to plug and abandon the WTR No. 1 and restore the surface be granted to Mr. James Woosley (Woosley Oil Company).

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Dear Mr. Woosley:

Texaco Inc. has been notified by the Bureau of Land Management that Woosley Oil Company, Operator, has failed to timely plug and abandon referenced well and restore the surface location. Referenced well was drilled on Federal Lease NM-10432, pursuant to the terms of that Farmout Agreement dated June 4, 1979, as amended, between Dome Petroleum Corporation and Trend Exploration, Ltd., as Farmors, and WTR Oil Company, as Farmee. The lease was terminated effective December 31, 1981 due to no production. Under the terms, Article No. 2 of said agreement, copy attached, WTR Oil Company (a/k/a Woosley Oil Company) is obligated to plug and abandon the subject well at its sole risk and expense.

Texaco does hereby demand that Woosley Oil Company plug and abandon WTR Well No. 1 and restore the surface no later than January 11, 1989, in conformance with the Bureau of Land Management requirements and restrictions.

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your well No. 1 WTR, SW/4SW/4 sec. 10, T. 19 N., R. 6 W., McKinley County, New Mexico, Terminated Federal lease NM-10432 which was operated by Woosley Oil Company. The subject lease was terminated effective December 31, 1981, due to no production. The operator (Woosley) submitted an intention to abandon dated May 5, 1987, and approved May 8, 1987. The operator requested an extension on June 7, 1988, and it was granted until September 14, 1988. The operator has requested an additional extension until September 21, 1988, due to rig problems. An inspection conducted by this office on November 22, 1988, found that the well has not been plugged. The lessees are responsible for making sure that the well is plugged timely. Therefore you are required to plug this well within 30 days.

You have 30 days to comply with this order. The 30 days commences upon receipt of this letter or seven days from the date it is mailed, whichever is less. Failure to comply within the 30 days will result in strict enforcement of 43 CFR 3163.1.

You are further advised that any instructions, orders or decisions issued by the Bureau of Land Management are subject to administrative review pursuant to 43 CFR 3165.3 and appeal pursuant to 43 CFR 3165.4 and 43 CFR 4.700.
