Dear Mr. Ludwick:

Raturned herewith unapproved are your Sundry Motices of Intent dated January 17, 1963, for the So. 1 Irra well located 2260' PSL and 1980' PWL sec. 35, T. 19 M., R. 5 W., McKinley County, New Mexico, on Federal oil and gas lease AM-6999.

This well was Plugged and Abandoned on June 27, 1980 as per Sundry Motice Subsequent Report of Abandonment dated July 7, 1980. Surface rehabilitation stipulations were forwarded to you on September 30, 1980. A Notice of Intent to re-enter the well was received on June 26, 1981 and approved June 30, 1981. An action was taken to complete the work. On October 3, 1982 another Sundry Notice was received requesting a waiver of approval to abandon which was approved October 14, 1982 for a period of 90 days, in which to re-enter the well, again no action was taken to complete the work.

Our records show the last production on this lease, as submitted by Cities Service Company, was in May 1962, in which the No. 1 Federal 2 well produced 64 bbl. oil and 1600 bbl. water. The No. 1 Federal E well was Flugged and Abandoned in October 1962, and was the last producing well on the lease. The lease went into its extended term on August 1, 1978.

Pursuant to CFR 43 Part 3107.3-1, this lease is considered to have terminated by law on May 31, 1982, the last day of the month in which hydrocarbons were last produced from the lease in its extended term. We diligent efforts to re-establish production were conducted within 66 days following cessation of production. By plugging the last well voluntarily, you indicate the lease is incapable of production.

Subject: Termination of Federal Lease NM-6999

Attached herewith is a copy of a letter to James L. Ludwick advising him that the above lease (NM-6999) has terminated by law for lack of producing hydrocarbons while in its extended term.

Reference 43 CFR 3107.3-1 and 3107.3-2, CDM 645.7.3C, and Director, BLM memo dated January 12, 1983. The stand of this office is as follows:

We have not written a 60-day letter to James L. Ludwick regarding the lease, because the Operator and Lessee voluntarily Plugged and Abandoned the four wells on this lease, the last being Flugged and Abandoned October, 1982. Therefore by so doing, they are, in effect substantiating our interpretation, which is, that the lease is no longer capable of production in paying quantities. The Sundry Notice referenced in the attached letter were intents to investigate a different zone.

Ludwick has had in excess of 12 years to perform the recentry and testing of a new zone, and has not shown diligence in the request.
