Merrion Oil & Gas requests the BLM's approval for an extension of time until December 1, 1993 in which to file plug & abandonment plans for this well. By sundry notice dated 1/26/93 Merrion advised the BLM that we may need this wellbore for produced water disposal, but that the decision would be based upon the results of a completion to be conducted on a nearby newly drilled well, the Chaco Wash No. 1.

For competitive reasons, Merrion must first pick up an offsetting lease before conducting the final completion of the Chaco Wash No. 1.

The lease in question was originally scheduled to be on the April, 1993 lease sale but did not make it. It will be on the July 21, 1993 sale.

We plan to commence final completion in August and in addition will need to run an extended test for 60 to 90 days following completion to make our decision.
