Enclosed are forms C-101 and C-128 for the Hancock-Sapir
Oil Company #15 Santa Fe Pacific R. R. well, in Section 20, T.
20 N., R 9 W., McKinley County, N. M.

You may recall that this well was the one discussed with
Dan Nutter, regarding the plan to set 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " casing on a shoulder
above the pay, delaying cementing until after coring indicates
whether a commercial well is possible.

I regret the delay in filing these forms with you. It
was not possible to file them until a survey had been completed.
Drilling has already commenced, and well #15 is at a total depth
of 528 feet, shut down for weather.
