Gentleman:

During a recent inspection by representatives from this office, a condition was noted on your Navajo allotted lease No. 14-20-603-3177 in sec. 15, T. 23 N., R. 7 W., Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, which must be corrected.

Your No. 1 Betty "B" well, located in the NE¼NW¼ sec. 15, is evidently producing on an intermitter and gas is periodically vented to a pit. The gas is vented with such force that small quantities of oil are carried over from the separator and blown completely across the pit and is polluting the natural drainage below the well.

You are requested to clean up the polluted area and maintain the equipment in such a manner that the situation will not recur.
