Spudded 9-29-66. Set 9 5/8" 36# casing @ 104' in 13 3/4" hole w/75 sks reg. cement, 2% CaCl₂. Circulated cement. WOC 12 hrs. Tested casing to 600#. TD 2810' in 7 7/8" hole on 10-2-66. Ran Electric Log through drill pipe. Ran 88 jts 4 1/2" 9.5 & 10.5# casing, set @ 2805'. Cemented w/100 sks 1:1 Diamix, 4% gel, 1/2# celloflake/sk and 100 sks Class C neat on 10-4-66. WOC. Perforated 2728-34 w/18 holes and 2738-40 w/2 holes. SWF w/40,000# 20-40 sand, 34,400g treatment water w/ 2 1/2# FR-2/1000g; 37,200g total water. FBD 2200#, TP 1500-1900#, Rate 44, SI 600#, 10 min SI 300#. Ran 82 jts 1 1/2" N.U. tubing, landed @ 2719'. Swabbed in, cleaned, shut in for IP test.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either are shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.

Item 4: If there are no applicable State requirements, locations on Federal or Indian land should be described in accordance with Federal requirements. Consult local State or Federal office for specific instructions.

Item 17: Proposals to abandon a well and subsequent reports of abandonment should include special information as is required by local Federal and/or State offices.
