Gentlemen:

The above well was spudded in the summer of 1970 and according to a sundry notice filed on August 4, 1970, the well depth at that time was 1075 feet.


On August 4, 1970, a letter was mailed to you from this office requesting further information and we received no response.

On June 22, 1972, a field inspection was made of this location. The rig is still standing over the hole which has 10 3/4 inch casing installed which is open.

In view of the long period of inactivity on this well, I am requesting that activity be resumed prior to August 15, 1972, or that the well be permanently plugged and abandoned.

In the event that response to this letter is not received prior to August 10, 1972, it is my intention to notify our attorney in Santa Fe to set a case before the Oil Conservation Commission to have you and the bonding company show cause why this well should not be plugged and abandoned.
