Merrion Oil & Gas Corporation plugged and abandoned the above referenced well as follows:

Nov. 5, 1996 RU rig and equipment. Layout relief lines to pit. Check well pressures: casing 900 psi, tubing and bradenhead 0 psi. Bleed well down to pit, casing would not die. PU on rods and unseat pump. POH & LD 5 rods, put stuffing box back on. SWI. SDFN.

Nov. 6, 1996 Open up well. PU rods & reseat pump. Load tubing with 7 bbls water, press test to 500# - held OK. Unseat pump. POH, LD 4 rods & put stuffing box back on. Pump 40 bbls water down tbg to kill casing. POH, LD total 225 rods, 120 - 3/4" and 105 - 5/8" rods with pump. Change over for tbg. Kill casing with 30 bbls water. ND WH & NU BOP. PU 1 jt tbg & tbg bottom at 5679'. **Plug #1** with 76 sxs Class B cmt from 5659' to 4657' inside csg to cover Gallup perfs and top. POH & tally 179 jts 2-3/8" tbg 5646'. SWI and WOC. SDFN.

Open up well. RIH with open ended tbg. tag cement at 4928'. Pulled up hole to 3627'. Load csg with 66 bbls water & circulate clean. Press test casing to 500# for 5 mins - held OK. **Plug #2** with 13 sxs Class B cement inside csg from 3627' to 3456' to cover Mesaverde top. Pull up hole to 2113'. **Plug #3** with 56 sxs Class B cement inside casing from 2113' to 1375' to cover Pictured Cliffs, Fruitland, Kirtland, and Ojo Alamo tops. POH, LD tbg. RU A-Plus WL truck. Perfd 3 squeeze holes at 405'. Establish circulation out bradenhead with 12 bbls water. **Plug #4** with 111 sxs Class B cement pumped down 4-1/2" casing from 405' to surface. Circ good cmt out bradenhead. SWI & WOC. Dig out wellhead. Open up well and ND BOP. Cut wellhead off, found cement at surface. Mixed 12 sxs Class B cement & installed P&A marker. RD rig and equipment. MOL. Note: Marilyn Deaton with BLM on location. (BC)
