DETAILS OF WORK

We propose to dual complete this well in the Gallup formation. Present TD of well is 6855' w/5 1/2" casing set @ 6855'. Dakota perforations are @ 6800'. The proposed work is as follows: set Model "D" packer between Dakota & Gallup formations. Perforate Gallup interval from 5643' to 5860' and sandfrac the Gallup. Set Model "MDX" packer @ 5600'. The Gallup will be produced through the tubing and the Dakota through the casing-tubing annulus. Approval has been obtained from the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission to dual complete this well.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
