PROVIDED FURTHER. That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual GOR Test Period for the Otero-Gallup Oil Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders of the Commission may deem necessary.
