On May 4, 1961 a notice of intention to plug form was approved by this office for the above well. Actually this form was approved in error, as Form C-105, Well Record Form, was not on file. However it was indicated on the plugging plan that you intended to cover the Pictured Cliffs Formation and set a cement plug from 615 to 640 to protect domestic water and set a 15-sack plug in the top of the casing.

We still have not received Form C-105, Well Record Form, nor have we received Form C-103, Miscellaneous Report showing that the plugging was done as stated in the Notice of Intention to Plug.
