The following is a report from Jean Orgeron, Grasso's site supervisor for the subject P&A operation:

September 14, 1990 - A-1 Well Service removed the tubing hanger and assembly from the well. Moved in and rigged up Schlumberger to make a gamma ray junk bucket run. CCL with 3.40 gauge ring. Tagged obstruction at 284'. Unable to get to the last recorded plug back depth. Pulled out of hole. Tripped in the hole with cement bond log (CBL) and logged 2449' to 4'. Indication of poor bond from 2442' to surface. Met New Mexico Oil & Gas Commission representative to review bond log. N.M.O.&G. required that we set a bridge plug with 100' of cement on top.

September 15, 1990 - Tripped in hole with CIBB. Tagged 2447'. Pulled up the hole to 2447' and set the bridge plug. POH and prepared to mix and dump cement. Made 13 runs. Dumped approximately 45' cement. Sheared plug on baler. Left 40' of 3 1/2" dump baler in the hole. Retagged baler on bottom. SDFN.

September 16, 1990 - Rigged up new baler and made 7 runs with dump baler. Left top of cement at 2347'. Coiled spool from surface. N.M.O.&G. representative accepted plug and signed off on affidavit transferring well to Henry Schmitz. All documents have been and notarized.
