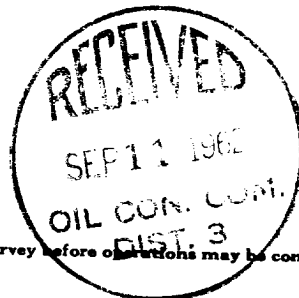

DETAILS OF WORK

Subject well spudded July 1, 1962. Set 96' of 8 5/8" surface casing and cemented with 60 sacks. Total depth reached July 9, 1962 of 3500'. Set 4 1/2" casing at 3487', and cemented with 100 sacks. Perforated 4 holes from 3394' to 3395'. Squeezed with 75 sacks of cement. Sand fraced August 13, 1962, with 12,000# sand.
