1. That he is President of Rio Chama Petroleum, Inc.

NM 87049, said well being drilled to test for hydrocarbons and/or carbon dioxide gas and described as the Crane Federal No. 3, being located 820 feet from the North line and 1050 feet from the West line of Section 32 Township 24 North, Range 01 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

3. That said well was drilled to a total depth of 3500' feet, and that casing has been set and cemented as follows:

8 5/8" at 96' w/60 sx
