
Dear Mr. Arnold:

Val R. Reese & Associates, Inc. have completed their Sperling #1-30 well located in the NE/4 SE/4 Section 30, T-24N, R-6W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico as a dual completion in the Gallup and Dakota formations. The Gallup section in this well is oil productive and the Dakota formation gas productive.

We are asking for a special test allowable of 600 barrels of oil under New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission rule 504. The transporter of said oil is to be McWood Corporation.

Further, the Gallup formation will be tested Thursday, December 17, 1959 and the Dakota formation tested Thursday, December 24, 1959 for packer leakage and initial potential purposes.
