Dear Elvis:

I have received a letter from Val R. Reese regarding their #1-30 Sperling well located in Unit I, Section 30-24N-6W in the Basin Dakota Pool. It states that this well last produced in November, 1960 and at that time was producing an average of 24 MCFPD. It states that a deliverability test was not filed in 1960 because production from the well was not sufficient or consistent enough for three weeks' conditioning and flow.

We are, therefore, sending in a gas supplement requesting that this well be issued an acreage allowable which I am certain will be large enough to cover its production at that rate of flow. After six months' production it should be eligible for an XM classification.
