We have received Federal Well Record Form 9-330, State Form C-104 and Form C-110 pertaining to the #1-29 Sperling well located in the SE₄ Section 29-24N-6W.

New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Rule 107 requires that tubingless slim-hole completions which are cased at a depth deeper than 5000 feet may be approved only after hearing. It is not clear from the forms filed whether or not this well is tubed inside the 2-7/8" casing.

Pool rules in the Devils Fork Gallup Pool require that a gas-oil ratio test, Form C-110, be filed with Form C-104, Request for Allowable, before an allowable is assigned. We did not receive this form on this well.

I would suggest that you contact Mr. Dan Nutter, Chief Engineer for the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission in Santa Fe, and make arrangements for a hearing to be set for the approval of the tubingless completion. The Santa Fe address is Box 871 and the telephone number is YU2-2641. We are holding the forms which you have submitted until the above requirements have been met.
