Amerada Petroleum Corporation has completed its J. Apache "B" Well No. 13, located 1000' from North Line and 1000' from East Line of Section 29, T24N, R5W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

The subject well was drilled to a total depth of 6838 and completed in the Basin Dakota Zone. A string of 3-1/2" (2.992 ID) casing was set at 6815 with D.V. Staging tool in string at 2446' to protect the Pictured Cliffs Zone.

Gas Volume reading on this well at end of 6 hour test was 700 MCF daily and made one (1) bbl. of distillate in 6 hour test.

No tubing has been run, therefore, we respectfully request an exception to Statewide Rule 107 (D)-(2) be granted.
