DETAILS OF WORK

The Federal 2-2651 was spudded October 21, 1957. Surface casing (8 5/8") was cemented at 319 feet with 200 sacks of cement. An estimated 25 sacks of cement were circulated. 7 7/8" hole was being drilled at 1733' at the end of the month.
