Reference is made to Mr. A. H. Hendrick's letter dated May 24, 1956, regarding Form O-125 submitted for Humble's Martin & Adams Tract of Indian "H" Well No. 2, Section 19, T-42-N, R-4-W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, and the indication of only 166.14 acres to said well.

Rule 101, Paragraph (d) and (f) of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission Rules and Regulations, requires that a gas well be located on a tract consisting of not less than a quarter of a section of approximately 160 surface contiguous acres substantially in the form of a square with a tolerance of from 158 to 162 acres. Since this unit contains only 124.14 acres, we request administrative approval since the shortage is due to the fact that the well is located on a short section. Please refer to attached plat.

We have furnished the oilfield operators a copy of this report by certified mail.

A non-standard drilling unit will be approved upon application to the Santa Fe office of the Commission. The process is an administrative procedure and does not require a public hearing.

We cannot approve the Forms C-110 until we get approval of the non-standard unit.

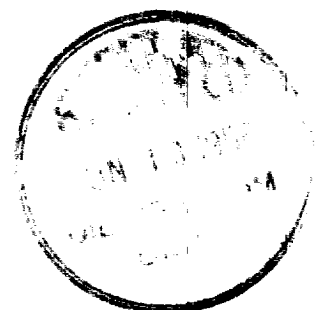

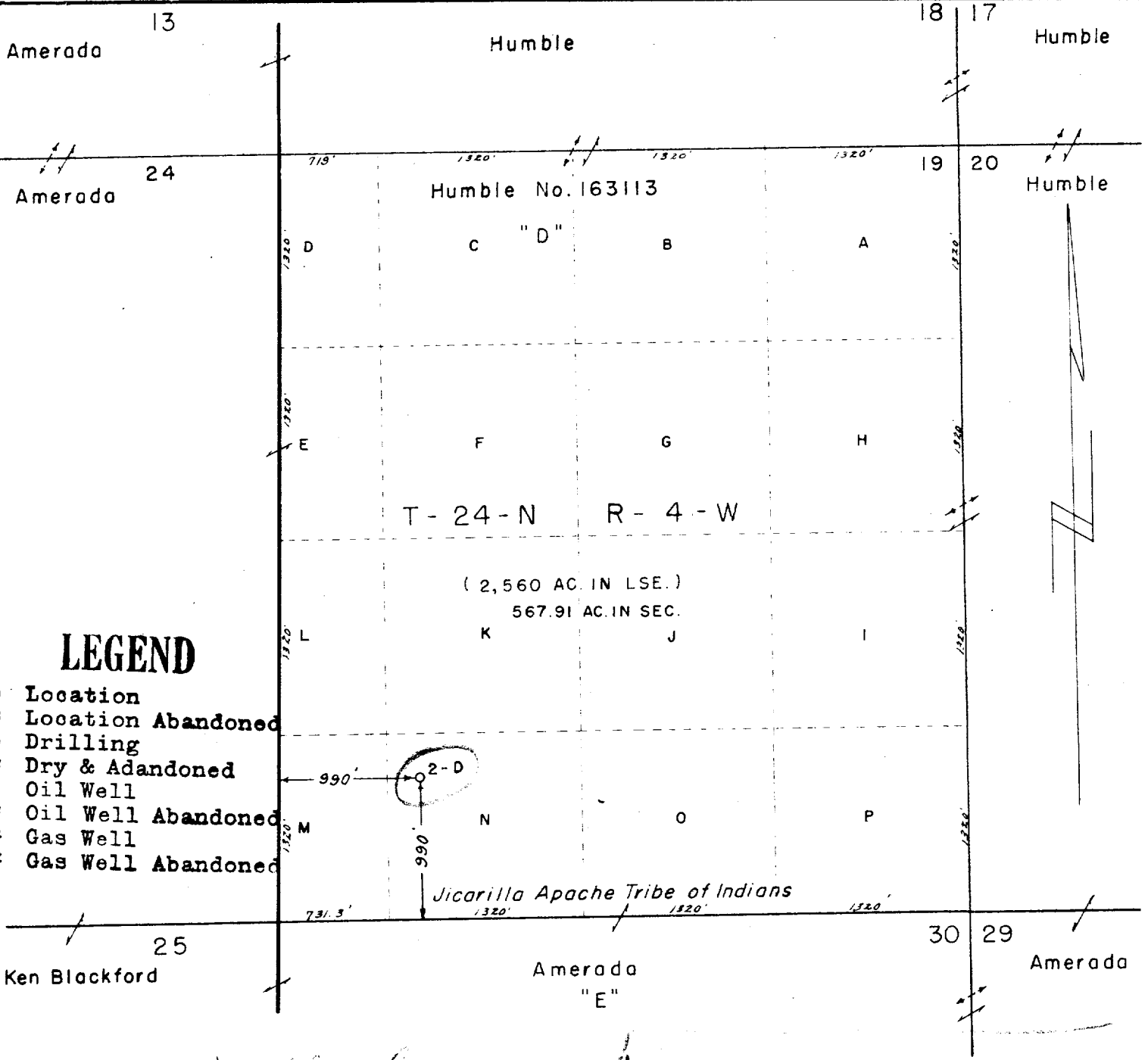

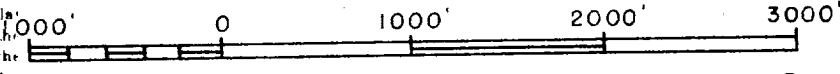


LEGEND
