This location was farmed out to Ed David, Farmington, New Mexico. The dry hole marker was removed. Intention was to check Chocra Sand 3980 to 4000 ft. Due to extreme weather conditions the hole was not perforated to my knowledge. Upon my insistence 2 3/8 inch tubing was run to 4000 ft. and ~~25XX25X~~ a 35 sack cement plug was set, tubing was pulled. I witnessed the cementing. The company that cemented the well was ASSOCIATED CEMENTERS, FARMINGTON, NEW MEXICO.

I would like to leave the well at this stage for the possibility of testing water sands from the top of the plug (approximately 3500 ft.) to the surface. El Paso Natural Gas Company have indicated interest in the above testing.

Instructions

General: This form is designed for submitting proposals to perform certain well operations, and reports of such operations when completed, as indicated, on Federal and Indian lands pursuant to applicable Federal law and regulations, and, if approved or accepted by any State, on all lands in such State, pursuant to applicable State law and regulations. Any necessary special instructions concerning the use of this form and the number of copies to be submitted, particularly with regard to local, area, or regional procedures and practices, either as shown below or will be issued by, or may be obtained from, the local Federal and/or State office.
