Administrative Order 7-17

Reference is made to your letter of January 2, 1963, wherein you request authority to complete your Licarilla Apache No. 1 well in the vicinity of the intersection of Highway 14 North and Highway 14 South, near the town of North, New Mexico. The well is located on the Licarilla Apache No. 1 well site, which is situated on the north side of Highway 14 North, about 1/2 mile north of the intersection of Highway 14 North and Highway 14 South. The well is to be completed with a gas-lift system and a tubingless completion. We have also received the gas-lift ratio report requested in our letter of February 6, 1963.

Based on your report that the well will produce with a gas-lift ratio in the neighborhood of 61,500 to one, there should be no production problem or waste encountered by your proposed completion.

Canada Petroleum Corporation is, therefore, hereby authorized to complete and produce the subject well in accordance with the procedure outlined in your letter of January 2.

The Commission does reserve the right, however, to review this matter at any time that it appears waste may be resulting from the proposed method of production.
