

Dear Mr. Arnold:

Attached is gas-oil ratio on the Byrd 1-23, located in the NE/4 of Section 23, T-24N, R-7W, in the Devils Fork Field, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico. The results of this ratio indicate that this well's classification has changed from gas to oil. Also attached is a Form C-128 showing the new acreage dedicated to this well. At the present time, the oil produced from this well is 40.3° API gravity. As provided in Case 2049, Special Rule 9-D, we request that this well be classified as an oil well, and an allowable be assigned.
