Amerada Petroleum Corporation has completed its J. Apache "B" Well No. 11, located 1000' from North line and 1000' from East line of Section 19. T24N. R5W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

The subject well was drilled to a total depth of 6665' and completed in the Basin Dakota Zone. A String of 3-1/2" (2.992 ID) casing was set at 6641' with D. V. Staging tool in string at 2235' to protect Pictured Cliffs Zone.

Gas Volume reading on this well at end of 5 hour test was 1,121 MCF daily and made no distillate.

No tubing has been run, therefore, we respectfully request an exception to Statewide Rule 107 (D)-(2) be granted.
