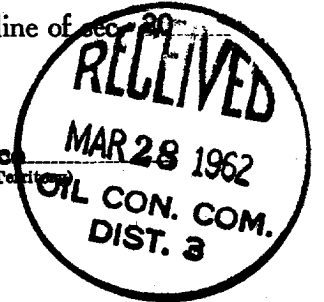

Ran and set 9-5/8" OD 25.4#, SW SJ Armeo Casing at 174', W/Baker TP Shoe on bottom and Larkin Centralizer at 165'; Cemented by Halliburton with 150 Sacks Reg. cement mixed 2% Calc. Chl. Pump plug to 154' W/200# Press. Finish at 3:00 AM 3/23/62. Cement Circulated, Est. 15 Sack return. WOC 24 Hrs.

3/24/62: Test 9-5/8" Surface casing for 1/2 hour W/500# press. held OK. Start Drilling 7-7/8" Formation Hole at 3:30 AM, 3/24/62.
