9-12-86 A pumper for BCO on his usual rounds discovered a man loading oil from tank number 2 at this well into his truck. The man identified himself as Dale Crawford of Mancos Corporation driving a Peterbilt truck with New Mexico license number 28671. Mr. Crawford told the BCO employee that his pup had gotten stuck. Mr. Crawford said he then unloaded oil from his truck into the BCO tank number 2. Then he loaded the oil from his pup to the truck and delivered it to Mancos. Our employee encountered Mr. Crawford when he was loading oil from our tank to his truck. Mr. Crawford broke seals number 07472 and 07473 to gain access to the storage tank at this well. We have resealed the tank with seals number 02433 and 02434. Robert Ramirez, field superintendent of BCO, reported this incident to Larry Pixley of the B.L.M., and Alice Dugger of the Oil Conservation Division. The well is not being produced into this tank. Our last gauge of this tank showed 1' 5 3/4". After Mr. Crawford finished loading oil, a re-gauge showed 1' 6".
