Dear Mr. Abraham:

We received your letter of December 12 pertaining to the #1 Schula well in Section 17-24N-1W. You state that you have not completed the well and will file the necessary instruments at the time of completion.

Our records indicate that this well was spudded in May of 1956 and our rules require that Form C-103 be filed within 10 days on casing tests, artificial stimulation and other operations on wells drilled on State or Patented land. On wells drilled on Federal Land, as this one is, we will accept the Federal Form 9-331-4 for miscellaneous reports; however we also require that if the Federal form is used in lieu of our form we receive it within the time required.

We have received nothing but a Notice of Intention to Drill on this well. We are therefore instructing that you immediately mail in Miscellaneous Reports covering your operation to date along with a statement as to the present status. Upon final completion complete information should be filed within 20 days. We would also like to know whether or not the well will be a producing well or if you intend to plug and abandon.

Dear Mr. Abraham:

We received your letter of December 16 regarding the 100 East 10th well. You stated that you have not completed the well and will file the necessary documents at the time of completion.

Our records indicate that this well was spaced in May of 1956 and our records require that Form O-103 be filed within 30 days of casing tests, and that it be filed with the necessary documents on Form O-103 on the same date. We will accept the Federal Form O-103-4 for this purpose, however we also require that the Federal Form O-103-4 be filed on the same date as the O-103-4.

We have received nothing but a notice of completion on this well. We are therefore insisting that you immediately file in Albuquerque reports covering your operation to date along with a statement as to the present status. When final completion information should be filed within 30 days. We would also like to know whether or not the well will be a producing well or if you intend to plug and abandon.
