Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for Redfern & Herd's Largo Spur Well No. 1 to be located 2160 feet from the South line and 1770 feet from the East line of Section 18, Township 24 North, Range 6 West, undesignated Dakota Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that this unorthodox well location is based upon extreme topographic conditions in the NW/4 SE/4 of said Section 18.

Inasmuch as you furnished waivers from the offset operators, it is possible for immediate approval to be granted. Therefore, by authority granted me under provisions of Rule 104 (f) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby granted an exception to Rule 104 (b) (2) of the Commission Rules and Regulations for the above described unorthodox well location. You must also obtain like approval from the U. S. Geological Survey if the well is located on land subject to the jurisdiction of the U. S. Geological Survey.
