The enclosed copies of Form C-122-A constitute a re-test of the deliverability of the McElvain Miller A-1 well in the NE/NE of Marken 13, T-24 North, R-7 West, Rio Arriba County, New Marken.

The original test of this well produced an allowable of 635 MCF water. Subsequent clear up of the Dakota formation, after water from proved the well capable of delivering approximately 950 MCF per day into the Southern Union gathering system. For this reason, the well was re-tested by the Danis Owens Company and found to the a deliverability of 823.6 MCF per day.

On the evidence of this re-test we would like to have the Dilleta monthly deliverability changed to 824 MCF per day.
