


THE APPLICATION OF CONTINENTAL OIL
COMPANY FOR A DUAL COMPLETION

ORDER NO. MC-1319



ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Continental Oil Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on May 7, 1963, for permission to dually complete its Northeast Haynes Well No. 2 located in Unit D of Section 16, Township 24 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce oil from the Gallup formation adjacent to the Otero-Gallup Oil Pool and gas from the Basin-Dakota Pool.

Now, on this 27th day of May, 1963, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Continental Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Northeast Haynes Well No. 2 located in Unit D of Section 16, Township 24 North, Range 5 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce oil from the Gallup formation adjacent to the Otero-Gallup Oil Pool and gas from the Basin-Dakota Pool through the tubing and the casing-tubing annulus, respectively.

PROVIDED HOWEVER. That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER. That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Basin-Dakota Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
