ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A (c) Paul F. Rutledge made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on March 7, 1961 for permission to dually complete its Miller Well No. B-5, located in the SE/4 SW/4 of Section 13, Township 24 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of oil from the Devils Fork-Gallup Pool and the production of gas from the Basin-Dakota Pool.

NOW, on this 27th day of March, 1961, the Secretary-Director finds:

(1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Subsection 'c' of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;

(2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and

(3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.

(4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.

(5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Paul F. Rutledge, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Miller Well No. B-5, located in the SE/4 SW/4 of Section 13, Township 24 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of oil from the Devils Fork-Gallup Pool and the production of gas from the Basin-Dakota Pool, through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Basin-Dakota Pool.
