DETAILS OF WORK

We propose to drill John A. Baker, Jr. No. 1 with rotary tools to an approximate total depth of 4000' to evaluate Gallun completion possibilities. Stimulation and completion will be as indicated upon reaching total depth. Casing program will be as follows:

2 1/2" x 2 1/2"	500'	700 sacks	Fast Circulate
5 1/2" x 7"	2000'	475 sacks	

The 5 1/2" production string will be cemented by the surface method with the 2-stage tool set approximately 100' below base of Pictured Cliffs; the first stage should bring top of cement back to 500' above top of Gallun and second stage to about 300' above Pictured Cliffs.

Series of location plat attached. Copies of any survey taken will be submitted upon completion of well.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

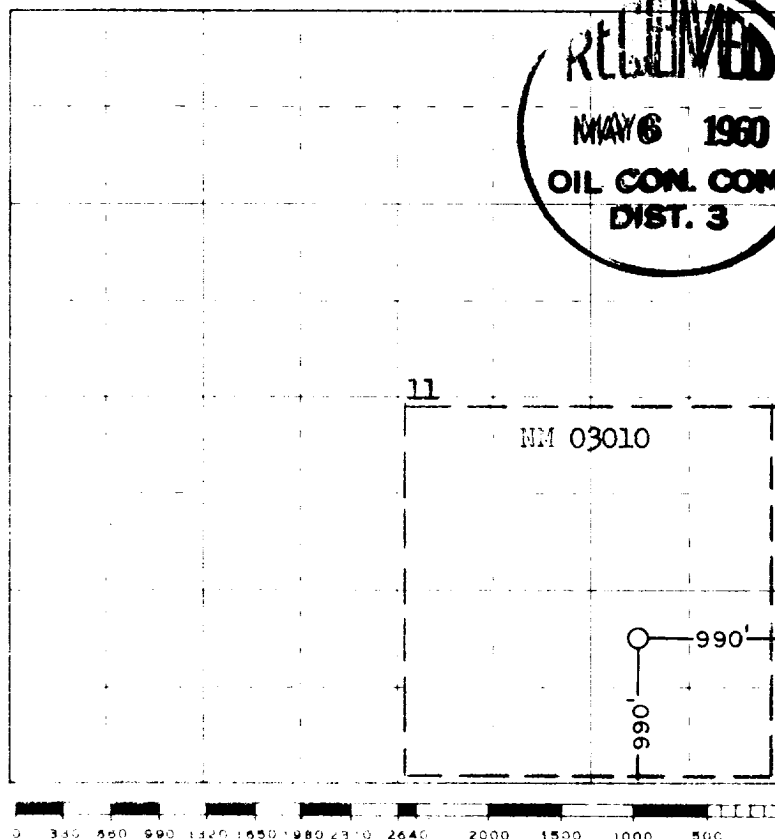
