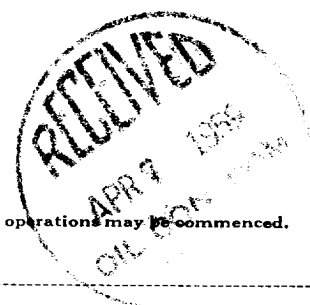

DETAILS OF WORK

March 31, 1959. This well was plugged and abandoned in the following manner:

1. Spotted 50 sacks regular cement on Pictured Cliffs perforations.
2. Shot off pipe at 1536 feet and recovered 5 1/2" casing above that point.
3. Spotted 25 sacks regular cement on 5 1/2" casing stub.
4. Plugged surface with 40 sacks regular cement.
5. Placed 4" x 4" marker.
