Held 500# for 30 minutes.

On 3-14-59. Total Depth 2200'.

Ran 53 joints 5 1/2", J-55, 15.50# casing (2190') set at 2200' with 43 sacks regular cement, 42 sacks Pozmix, 2# Gel, 1/4 cu. ft. Stratacrete "6"/sack followed with 50 sacks Best cement.

Held 1000# for 30 minutes.

Top of cement by temperature survey at 1530'.
