The standard proration unit for the Basin-Dakota gas pool is 320 acres. The Plat we have on file shows 320 acres dedicated but the questions below regarding communitization do not indicate this to be the case.

We will be unable to issue an allowable for the Dakota zone of this well until we have on file a plat showing 320 acres dedicated, with the unit outlined on the plat so that we will know which half-section comprises the proration unit.
