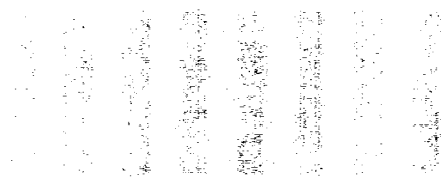



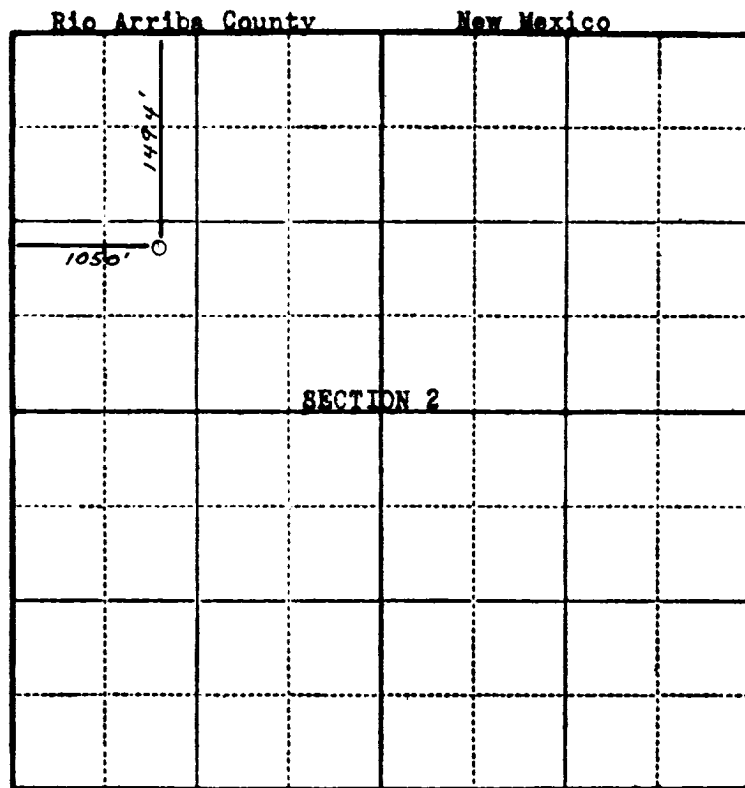

Abstract—The purpose of this study was to determine whether the use of a computerized program could improve the accuracy of the measurement of the resting heart rate (HR) by means of a heart rate monitor (HRM). The HRM was used to measure the HR at rest during the morning and evening sessions of two consecutive days. The HRM was connected to a personal computer which stored the HR values and calculated the mean HR. The results showed that the use of the computerized program improved the accuracy of the measurement of the resting HR compared with the manual calculation method.
