It is understood that this unit is to be dedicated to your Canyon Large Unit Well No. 83, located 990 feet from the North and West lines of said Section 1.

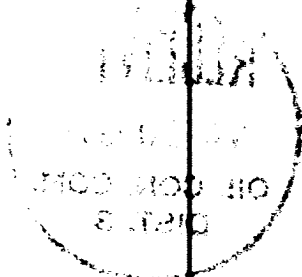
