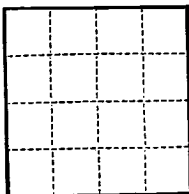

DETAILS OF WORK

It is our intention to drill well No. 3 to approximately 6000' to test the Mesquite formation for oil. Our casing program is as follows:

300' of 10-3/4" CB (32.75%) casing - cemented with 250 lbs. reg. cement - circulated.
6000' of 5-1/2" CB (15.5%) casing - cemented with 300 lbs. reg. cement - Halliburton

The designated drilling unit is the NW 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 5-24N-3W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

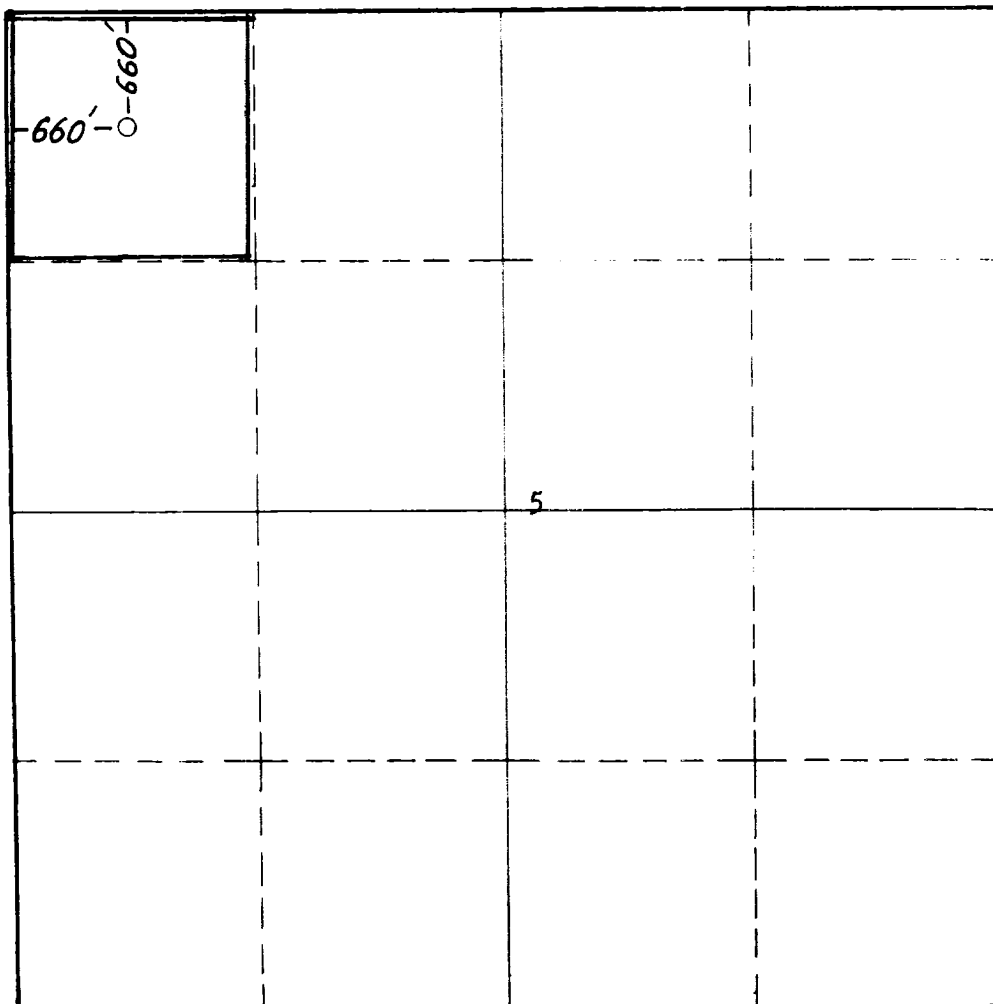
